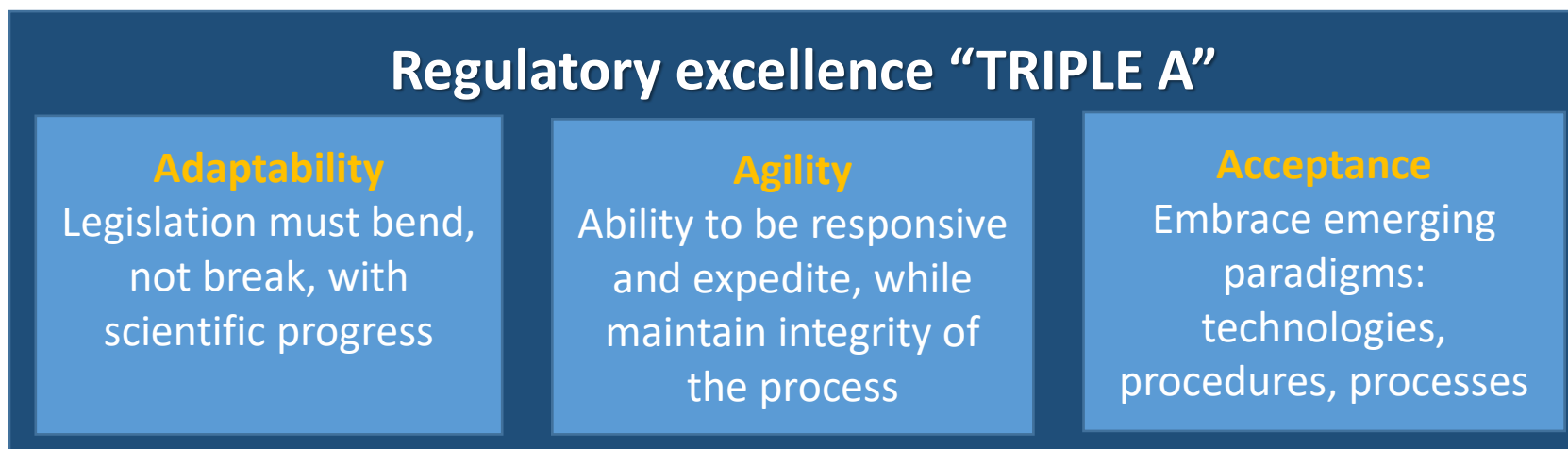
Constant adaptability to the shifting landscapes and weather
