Why are NAMs important for FAST?

- **Accelerating Innovation:** Enable faster, smarter, and cost-effective development of new therapies by introducing advanced, human-relevant models and reducing reliance on traditional animal testing.
- **Derisking:** developing and implementing human-relevant models for lead selection and in pre-clinical development leads to a higher success rate of clinical studies
